Inside and out of the runways, Alexander Wang seems to hold the same minimalist and dark style. Poltrona Frau invited him to sign a limited series of lounge furniture and the designer accepted, imprinting his trademark in a beanbag style sofa and a trunk bar. The furniture created by Wang is predominantly black and made of the same materials the stylist usually uses on his runway creations: leather and velvet fabric. As it should be, the designer also considered comfort, adding details, such as a slight inclination, in order to lend anatomic contours to the furniture. The price on each piece is what makes sure they are exclusive. The beanbag sofa, for instance, is sold for over eight thousand dollars.
